A better way for your Finance team to use Excel with VISUAL

The Business Issue

If you're in Finance you use Excel to analyze data out of VISUAL. In the best case scenario, data is exported into Excel from VISUAL. However, the data still needs to be formatted. The worst case scenario is data is manually entered into Excel. Either way consumes too much non value-added time for information that may not be real time. In addition, the financial team understands the G/L structure, but not how to create reports with drill-down functionality.

The Solution

Spreadsheet Server is designed for the financial end of the business. The data source is your G/L structure; no query development required. Simply define a G/L account (or group of accounts) in each row, and the period in each column, and your financial report is done; with full drill-down capabilities to real-time data. Need consolidated reports for multiple VISUAL databases? It's a snap with Spreadsheet Server.

Once the spreadsheet is formatted, the data is automatically updated with the click of a mouse. Share the knowledge with people inside or outside your organization with the built in Distribution Manager.

The Result

You will spend your time analyzing and sharing data, not collecting and formatting data. Also, you will be using a tool everyone in your company knows: Excel. Leverage your organization's knowledge of Excel, get the answers you need, and made better decisions.
